

Diversity everywhere...

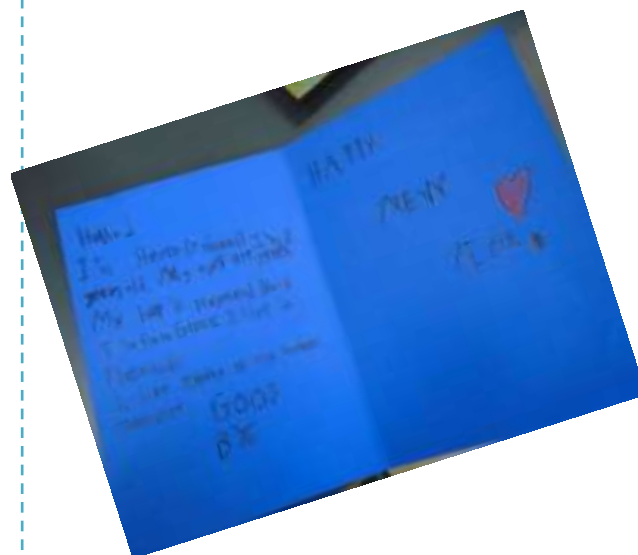
